

TAYLORED SCIENCE Personal Possessions Policy

Taylor Science can take no responsibility for the safe keeping of children's personal possessions during activities unless a specific agreement has been made between the parent of the child and Taylor Science.

Taylor Science would ask that children do not bring any personal possessions to activity sessions, other than essential items.

If a child has their mobile phone in school, it should never be taken out of their bag during a STEM Club session.

If a child is asked to wear an apron, they should do so, to help protect their clothing from spills or other damage. Taylor Science will provide an apron for each child.

Taylor Science will always take steps to ensure that children's clothing and other items are protected from the substances we use and from other accidental damage, however, it is not possible to protect against all eventualities.
